Summary: Under the direct supervision of the Assistant Foreman performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled work on irrigation and landscape construction projects.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following:

- Ability to follow instructions
- Able to understand and follow Company safety procedures
- Ability to adapt in a changing work environment
- Operate and maintain a variety of light equipment and power tools
- Project duties include cleaning, sweeping, vacuuming, raking, trimming, mowing, weeding, edging, digging, watering and other duties as assigned
- Maintain, repair and install automatic irrigation systems and related fixtures
- Apply herbicides, pesticides and fertilizers on turf, trees, shrubs, ground covers, flowers and all other areas requiring weed and pest control
- Interact and communicate with customers, inspectors and contractors as required
- Ability to work extended hours in all weather conditions

Miscellaneous:

- Assist with the removal of damaged/broken vehicles and equipment at the job sites
- Dispose and replace unsafe tools and equipment
- Perform other landscape maintenance duties as assigned
- Use company cell phone for official business
